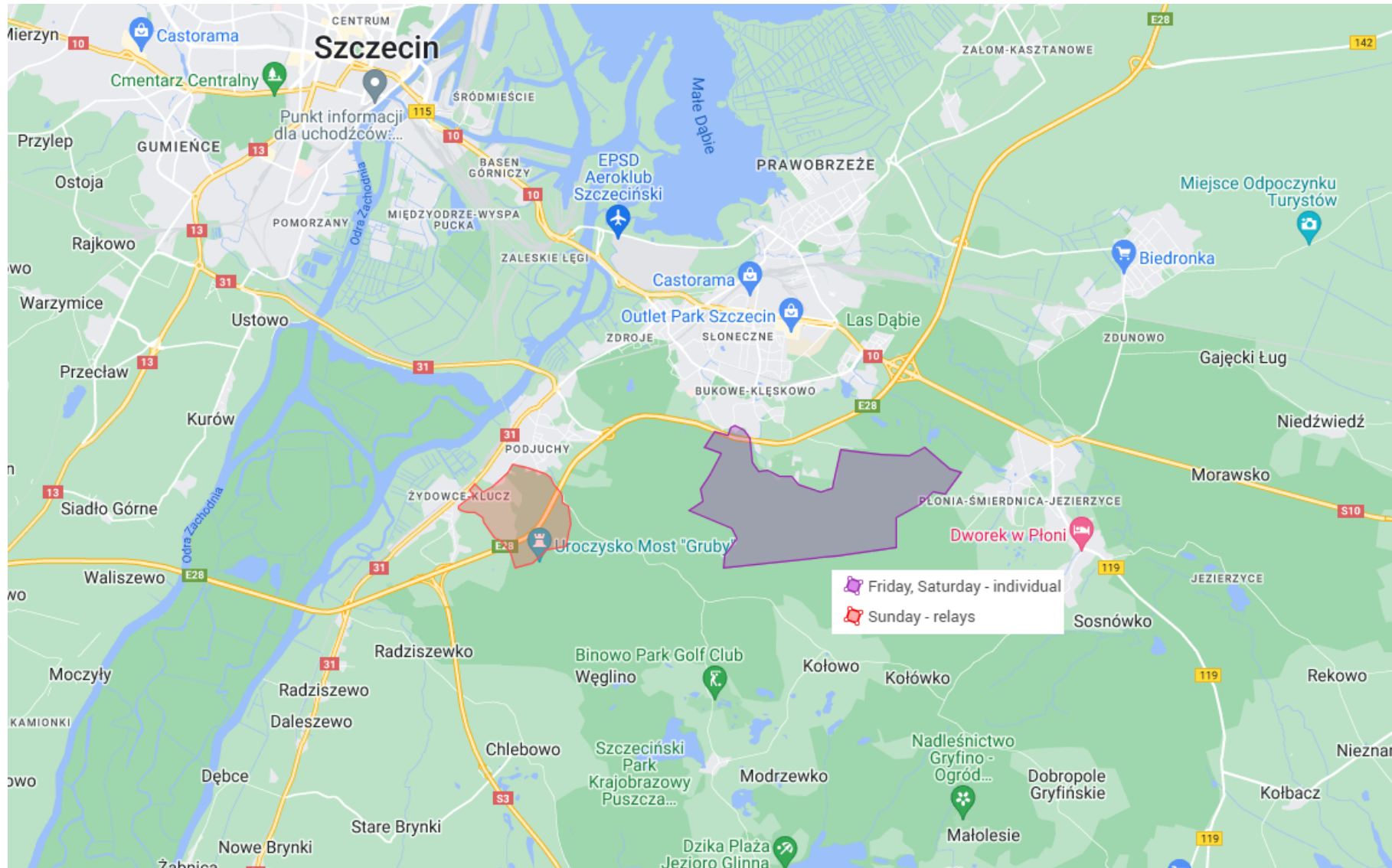

PARTICIPATION

Representing the BJC nations/regions: Denmark, Estonia, Finland (FSO), Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Sweden (Småland) and Sweden (South Sweden).

Optionally other nations after consultation with the above National Teams. Competitors who are not eligible to participate in the BJC are encouraged to participate in the Baltic Junior Cup Tour. All age categories will be available.

OFFICIAL CAMP BEFORE EYOC 2024

Baltic Junior Cup is the official camp before EYOC 2024.

The official camp will take place from 27 th October to 1 st November.

On Friday, Saturday and Sunday during the camp, we offer participation in the Baltic Junior Cup. We encourage competitors who don't participate in the BJC to take part in the Baltic Junior Cup Tour. During the BJCT there will be a middle distance on Friday, a long distance on Saturday and a middle distance on Sunday. All age categories will be available. From 30 th October (Monday) to 1st November (Wednesday) we would like to organize two training sessions a day with SportIdent. If anyone is interested in participating on a different date, please let us know. After consultation, we will prepare and print maps.

PUCHNING SYSTEM

The Baltic Junior Cup competition will be held using the SportIdent electronic confirmation system. It is possible to rent an SI chip from the Organizer. This should be indicated in the application.

The SportIdent AIR+ contactless checkpoint confirmation system will be used during the competition.

CATEGORIES

Long-distance: M16, W16, M18, W18, M20, W20.

Women and men have the same ideal winning times; these are gender-neutrally adapted times based on IOF's instructions for winning times in JWOC and EYOC:

Classes	Minutes, women	Minutes, men

W/M 16	45	45
W/M 18	55	55
W/M 20	70	70
Relay, each leg	30-35	30-35

Mixed relay: 1st leg M18 (1st runner) and W18 (2nd runner); 2nd leg M16 (3rd runner) and W16 (4th runner); 3rd leg M20 (5th runner); 4th leg W20 (6th runner).

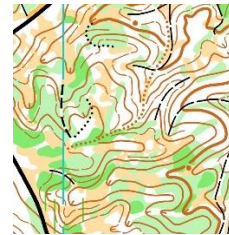


TERREINS AND MAPS

ENTRIES AND FEES

Applications will be accepted via OrienteeringOnline or via <https://orienteering.org.pl/>

In the relay name application, please provide all details of each leg (name, surname, year of birth, classes, SI number).

The organizer will provide a Google sheet for viewing with the reported relay teams.

Last entry date is 16 October.

For each runner:
