CTZ ranked competition with Z=1.10.



PARTICIPATION

According to the PZOS regulations, competitors participating in CTZ competitions who want to participate in sports competitions organized by PZOS (competition for ranking points) are obliged to have a valid PZOS license. However, the lack of a license does not exclude players from sports competition during the Bukowa Cup, the competition is open to everyone.

Everyone is required to have valid medical examinations. Persons taking part in the Bukowa Cup competition who do not have valid medical examinations are obliged to present a declaration of starting at their own risk in the competition office.


OFFICAL CAMP BEFORE EYOC 2024

CONTROL POINTS

The Bukowa Cup competition will be held using the SportIdent electronic confirmation system. It is possible to rent an SI chip from the Organizer. This should be indicated in the application.

The SportIdent AIR+ contactless checkpoint confirmation system will be used during the competition.

TERREINS AND MAPS

STAGE 1

The area consists of two parts: 50% the area of a typical Polish housing estate, 50% an estate of single-family houses. Flat terrain. There is normal car traffic on the area.

The area has never been used for Orienteering competitions.


Typical moraine, with very good to very difficult runability with a well-developed road network. The forest is heavily used economically.

STAGES 3 AND 6

Typical moraine, with very good to very difficult runability with a well-developed road network. The forest is heavily used economically.

Maps: scale categories KM14 and younger and above KM40 - 1:10,000, veterans from KM65 1:7 500, others 1:15 000, e=5m, ISOM 2017, A4 format, updated spring 2023.







STAGE 4

Typical moraine, with very good to very difficult runability with a well-developed road network. The forest is heavily used economically.

Map: "Jezioro Binowskie", scale categories KM14 and younger and above KM40 – 1:10,000, veterans from KM65 1:7 500, others 1:15 000, e=5m, ISOM 2017, A4 format, spring 2023.








STAGE 5

The first part of the terrain is a flat area that is a military training ground. It is characterized by a large number of holes, depressions, ditches and various military infrastructure facilities. Runnerability from very good to difficult. The second part is a typical moraine, with very good to very difficult runability with a well-developed road network. The forest is heavily used economically.

ACCOMMODATION

It is possible to book accommodation in a Hostel near the Competition Center (14 km) for 70 PLN per night, in Primary School No. 47 in Szczecin (25 km) for 15 PLN per night, as well as in the Bukowina scout hostel in the Competition Center. We have 60 places in houses (mostly bunk beds, 6 people in a room) for 35 PLN per night, a camping site and places in the common room on the floor – 25 PLN per day. 


CLOSED TERRAINS

The organizer closes the area where the BukowaCup 10 Competition will be held under the following conditions:


Sprint - Stage 1

It is acceptable to remain in the closed area as a resident, student or while in business or leisure travel. It is prohibited to remain in the terrain with orienteering map, running or orienteering.



Forrest Courses - Stages 2-6

The closed area is banned from any physical activity, including walking, running, biking or skiing, etc. It is prohibited to organise other Orienteering competitions in this area



INFORMATION AND RECOMMENDATION REGARDING COVID-19 PANDEMIC

Due to the limitations related to counteracting COVID-19, all competitors are required to strictly comply with the recommendations and regulations of the Council of Ministers, the Minister of Health, the Minister of Sport and Tourism and the Chief Sanitary Inspector in force on the day of the competition.
