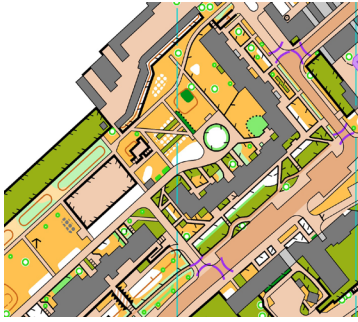
### RULES:

Rules of Polish Orienteering Federation are applied.

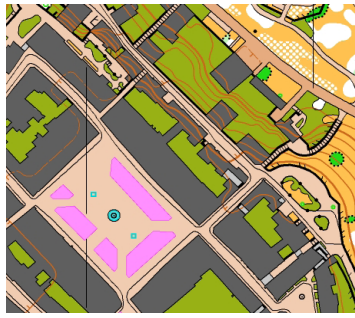
### MAPS:

- Szmulowizna - scale 1:5000 (map with 100 canopies)

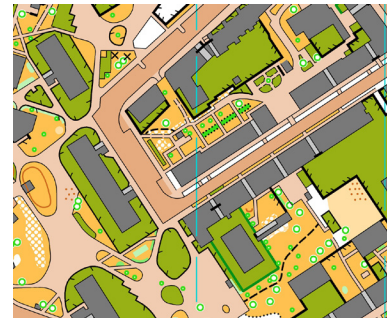
### Plac Konesera
